Cover can be used multiple times for different crises and typically includes: ransom costs, legal liabilities, crisis consultancy costs, death and disability payments and additional expenses.

Core insurance covers



Extortion

Covers illegal threats to kill, injure, abduct clients' people, to damage property or disseminate trade secrets or confidential information.



Hijack

Covers hijacks, when people are held against their will while travelling. Example scenarios include plane hijackings, protracted carjackings and water vessel seizures.



Detention

Covers any detention (eg by government authorities) lasting over 3 hours and unrelated to a proven criminal offence or to failure to produce correct documentation.



Disappearance

Covers investigation costs following the disappearance of an insured person who has been missing for more than 48 hours, whatever the reason.



Kidnap

Covers any alleged, attempted or actual kidnap via the industry leading support AIG's global response partner NYA.



Security Evacuation

Covers the extraction of internationally based personnel from any location worldwide should the security environment significantly deteriorate. Cover can be extended to salaries and relocation costs.



Express Kidnap

Covers shorter term abductions typically of a few hours with the intention of rapid financial gain (such as repeatedly forced withdrawals from an ATM).



Threat

Crisis consultancy for initial threat assessment and additional security recommendations so clients can respond immediately to any concern and resolve before matters get out of control.
